Re: CM/ECF Version 3.3 Live Date on January 1, 2009

On January 1, 2009, the United States Bankruptcy for the District of Utah will be upgrading the CM/ECF database from Version 3.2 to Version 3.3. The ECF and PACER database and VCIS will be unavailable on January 1, 2009, starting at 12:00 am, and should be down for several hours. The new version of the software is a relatively small release, however there are a few modifications which may impact ECF filers and PACER users.

One of the main modifications of release 3.3 will be the method in which debtor(s) dispositions such as a discharge or dismissal are reported and displayed. In previous releases, the disposition was listed on a case level regardless if the case included a debtor and joint debtor. Now under version 3.3, any case closed on or after 1/1/2009 will report the disposition of each debtor separately within CM/ECF.

Another modification which will be part of Version 3.3 will be the collection of additional statistical data required by the Executive Office of the United States Trustee. The additional data collection will occur during the opening of bankruptcy case. Additional data will also be required of the Panel Trustees as they docket Reports of No Distribution.

In anticipation of this new release, ECF filers should contact their 3rd party software vendors to ensure their software is compliant with CM/ECF Version 3.3. Likewise, other customers of the court are encouraged to explore any anticipated complications as a result of the new reporting system of separate dispositions. Additional information regarding Version 3.3 will be distributed in the near future.
