Re: Standing Order Number 5 Regarding the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008 and Amended Official Form B22A

For Reservists and members of the National Guard called to active duty or homeland defense activity for at least 90 days, the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, Pub.L. 110-438, provides a 540 day temporary exclusion from the bankruptcy means test measured from the date service ends. The Judicial Conference has approved an amendment to Official Form 22A which includes a new Part 1C where qualifying debtors can invoke the temporary exclusion from the means test. **The amended form will be effective on December 19, 2008**, the same time the statute is effective.

Standing Order Number 5 has been issued by the court adopting Interim Rule 1007-1 and Amended Form B22A. The order becomes effective December 19, 2008, and is available at the clerk's office front counter or on the website under the local rules link.
