In Re: Chapter 13 341 Calendaring

Commencing 7/17/05, the Clerk's office is assuming calendaring duties from the Chapter 13 trustees. A setting of a 341 will occur soon after a Chapter 13 is filed just as it presently occurs in Chapter 7's. There are a few issues that need to be clarified:

- 1) The list of creditors (matrix) needs to be submitted within 2 days of the filing, per local rule. This filing has not been as crucial when the trustees calendared because there was a "grace period" inherent in the system. This grace period will no longer exist;
- 2) The Chapter 13 plan will still be sent with the notice if it is on file when the 341 notice is queued to the BNC; this period of time fluctuates dramatically, and is based on when a case is filed, how filled a particular calendar is, and how close the actual 341 meeting is to being held;
- 3) The confirmation date and time will be set and sent to all creditors, ~~but it will appear on a separate notice mailed with the 341 and plan; this hearing will also serve as your date for any objections to dismissals that are filed;~~
