**In Re:** Noticing of Motions to Confirm by Consent

I am pleased to announce that in the very near future the Clerk's office will provide a service that you may be interested in using for your Chapter 13 cases. The Clerk's office will notice your Motions to Confirm by Consent to all creditors for you, with several conditions:

- 1) The motion must be filed ECF;**
- 2) If you wish it sent by the Clerk's office, you must also e-file a text-only "request" to have it mailed by the clerk's office (an event code will be provided). The motion and request to mail must be filed the same day in order for the Clerk's office to mail the motion;**
- 3) The Clerk's office will only mail it once; any subsequent "amended" or "corrected" motion is the practitioner's responsibility to mail;**
- 4) If you wish to also have an amended plan sent at the same time with your motion, the docket event code "Motion to Confirm by Consent and Ch13 Amended Plan" instead of just the standard event code "Motion to Confirm by Consent" should be used.**

A notice will be distributed when this service is in place. The certificate of mailing will be from the BNC, automatically docketed, and identical in form to the present 341 meeting certificate of mailings. Thank you.
