**Opinion Title:** 10/01/2010 UNPUBLISHED Rupp v. Wood, 09-2482, Judge Mosier.

**Body:** A chapter 7 trustee is not entitled to a default judgment on his complaint objecting to debtor's discharge under § 727 and seeking a money judgment against the debtor unless his complaint contains specific factual allegations which constitute a legitimate cause of action. Mere conclusory allegations without supporting factual averments are insufficient to state a claim upon which relief may be granted.
