General Order No.: 20-002

In response to the threat to public health posed by the COVID-19 virus, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah deems it necessary to develop a protocol to assist in the effort to stem the spread of that virus. In furtherance of that effort, the Court hereby ORDERS as follows:

Unless otherwise ordered by the hearing judge, all hearings scheduled in the Court through April 13, 2020 shall be conducted by telephone. Counsel and parties with hearings scheduled through April 13, 2020 are instructed to contact chambers to make arrangements to appear telephonically.

The Court may extend or revise this order as the exigencies of the circumstances merit.
