David A. Sime, Clerk of Court for the U.S. Bankruptcy Court, District of Utah is pleased to announce several significant milestones that have recently occurred at the Court.

On September 3, 2015, the Honorable William T. Thurman stepped down as Chief Bankruptcy Judge of the Court completing his term as a full-time Bankruptcy Judge. During the past six years of his fourteen year term, Judge Thurman served as the Court's Chief Bankruptcy Judge. The Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals has reappointed him to serve as a Bankruptcy Judge, in recall status, for the next three years, during which time he will continue to hear cases that originate in the Southern Division of the District of Utah along with some cases in the Court's Central and Northern Divisions. Judge Thurman also stepped down from the Bankruptcy Appellate Panel for the Tenth Circuit where he served as an appellate judge for twelve years, including the past three years as Chief Judge.

The Honorable R. Kimball Mosier has been appointed as the Court's new Chief Bankruptcy Judge, effective September 4, 2015. He has served as a Bankruptcy Judge for the past six years. In addition, Chief Bankruptcy Judge Mosier has been appointed as an appellate judge to the Bankruptcy Appellate Panel for the Tenth Circuit.

Also effective September 4, 2015, the Court welcomes the Honorable Kevin R. Anderson as the Court's newest Bankruptcy Judge. Judge Anderson was most recently the Chapter 13 Standing Trustee for the District of Utah.
