General Order No.: 20-004

In its General Order 20-002, the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah ordered that, unless otherwise ordered by the hearing judge, all hearings scheduled in the Court through April 13, 2020 would be conducted by telephone in order to stem the spread of the COVID-19 virus. The order further provided that the Court could extend it as the exigencies of the circumstances merited. The Court determines that the circumstances warrant an extension of that order and hereby ORDERS as follows:

Unless otherwise ordered by the hearing judge, all hearings scheduled in the Court through May 1, 2020 shall be conducted by telephone. Counsel and parties with hearings scheduled through May 1, 2020 are instructed to contact chambers to make arrangements to appear telephonically.

The Court may extend or revise this order as the exigencies of the circumstances merit.
