GENERAL ORDER NO. 21-001

The Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah will be performing a system upgrade of the Court's Case Management and Electronic Case Filing system (CM/ECF) to NextGen CM/ECF (NextGen) starting on June 3, 2021 and ending on June 5, 2021. As a consequence of this upgrade, users of the Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah's CM/ECF system will not be able to file documents or query the system for information, including through Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER). Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 105 and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9006, all deadlines in contested matters under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9014, adversary proceedings under Fed. R. Bankr. P. 7001 *et. seq.*, and all other matters that expire on June 3-4, 2021 are hereby extended to Monday, June 7, 2021.
